Together We Vaccinate – Impact & Update

- Pivoted from Covid testing to Covid vaccinations April 2021
- Partnership began with UTSW @ Red Bird Mall (1st and 2nd dose clinics)
- Resumed partnership with Catalyst Health Network after acquiring our own channel for vaccines
- Created grass-roots operation to take the vaccine to the people via strategic relationships
- Updated operations alongside CDC and FDA
- Created PSA targeting the Hispanic community using a family who attended a vaccination clinic in Pleasant Grove
- To date:
 - 2,432 shots administered; 12 site partners; 17 different locations around Dallas County; 40 events; over 250 individual volunteer roles filled; over 800 volunteer hours served; supported 2 partner 2nd dose clinic events
 - Served the communities most vulnerable - homeless, low income, residents of men's half-way houses

Together We Learn – Impact & Update

- During pandemic we began partnerships with Big Brother Big Sister, Texas Can Academy and Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity to host virtual program events
- Partnership with Jesuit Dallas Social Justice Program launched fall 2021
 - 200 senior students completed the training
 - 91% of students improved their understanding of laws related to driving
 - 95% of students improved their understanding of how to act and react to law enforcement during a traffic and pedestrian stop
 - 75% of students had a positive perception change about law enforcement
- Establishing relationships with new school partners for spring 2022 program events
- Established partnership with Southern Methodist University to develop a Virtual Reality program module
- Presented funding case to Senator Cornyn and State Senator Royce West for federal funding consideration
 - Senate Bill 30

Together We Can – Impact & Update

- 15 corporate and organizational partners engaged
- Employee reach with corporate partners are thousands who receive our TWC information via internal corporate communication mediums
- 850 individuals enrolled
- 13,145 wristbands distributed
- Launched partnership with Tom Thumb to sell wristbands in 29 Dallas county stores
- Monthly Action Item Newsletter observances ranged from MLK, Jr., Black History month, Women's History month, National Hispanic Heritage month, Asian-American Pacific Islander month, to the Tulsa Race Massacre and Sports History
- Organically became a DEI Solution for organizations and companies

- 76 Dines completed
- 2,822 people participated
- 48 facilitator volunteers on roster
- 539 individual facilitator roles utilized
- 1,096 Volunteer hours served
