



Together We Sing signature fundraiser had a record year with exciting engagement:

- Event grossed more than \$300K
- Sold out audience over 1,800 attendees
- 60 Orchestra members
- 189 Diverse choir members
- 40 volunteers

Together We Learn – Impact & Update

- Fall 2022 partnership schools yielded:
 - 790 senior students completed the training
 - 94.85% of students improved their understanding of laws related to driving
 - 95.79% of students improved their understanding of how to act and react to law enforcement during a traffic and pedestrian stop
 - Post training perception of law enforcement
 - 17.47% much more positive
 - 45.55% positive
 - 33.07% no change
- Spring 2023 sessions includes 5-8 schools targeting 1,000-1,300 students
- Continuing partnership with Southern Methodist University to develop a Virtual Reality program module
 - Seeking Federal funding to support this initiative

Together We Dine – Impact & Update

As of Nov. 30

- 66 Dines completed (virtual and in-person)
- 3,048 people participated
- 64 facilitator volunteers on roster locations include Waco, Houston, Atlanta and Boston
- 580 individual facilitator roles utilized
- 1,178 Volunteer hours served
- Notable quotes from attendees
- "Loved the small group dynamic, hearing personal stories from each participant and understanding we all have more in common than we know if we take the time to listen."
- "I learned that we all make internal assumptions about people when we meet them on the surface level. But most of the time, these can be incorrect assumptions. This opportunity allowed me to hear what others had to say and it really helped me get to know them and learn that there is so much more to them."
- "The most impactful thought that I had from this program experience is that I am not forced to think about my race on a daily basis, but many other people are."
- "That everyone has a story, no matter what their race is."
- "I was reminded of how valuable it is to hear the perspectives and experiences of others, and that there is value in sharing about my own experience. I really appreciate this opportunity."

Together We Vaccinate – Impact & Update

- TWV: April 2021 April 2022
- Provided vaccinations to persons living 81 different Zip codes
- Hosted 50 vaccination events
- Vaccinated 2,665 individuals
- Administered 1st and 2nd doses, boosters; children to seniors
- Worked with 8 collaboration partners
 - Catalyst Health Group, Dallas Mavericks, St. Luke Community UMC, The Concilio, BaylorScott & White, National Council of Negro Women, Amazon, Green Hills UMC
- 15 different site locations in Dallas County
- Utilized over 100 individual volunteers
